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MOI. The term Moi is often used in a very broad sense in the west Bird's Head to include most languages. Abun, Seget, Kalabra, As, Moraid, Mare (a dialect of Brat) have all been referred to as Moi. It seems to be used as a cover all [sic] term for 'language' by those who live around Sorong.
