De stam der Barapassi heeft zich aan den middenloop van de Barapassi in een zevental kleine kampongs gevestigd, van welke de kampongs Kamassano (Barapassi), Eroina en Wobia de belangrijkste zijn.

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### (BAROPASI)

Taru\_gare is spoken near the township of Nabire at the bottom of the Geelvink Bay; Baropasi is located about 200 km north-west of Nabire, and Bauri is spoken near Lake Holmes in the mountains south-east of Baropasi. The exact areas covered by them, and their numbers of speakers are not known, and it is possible that there are still other languages belonging to the same family in the same general area -- the figure of 3,000 speakers or so may perhaps be not too far from the mark.
