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De Boromesso's zouden in Kauwerowedja komen korewarieën, als enigen van de overkant van de Mamberamo. Huwelijksrelaties met de Boromesso zijn echter uitgesloten.

Het zwerfgebied ligt oostelijk van de Mamberamo, tussen de Edi-vallen, Mamasin en kaap Bogor. Voorts mag langs de Weri-rivier gezworven worden in de gebieden van de Soromadja's en de Sagowedja's. Havikseiland valt ook binnen hun beschikkingssfeer.

Op de linkeroever van de Mamberamo mogen ze jagen in het gebied van de Boromesso's, zo mogen er echter niet overnachten en de landbouw uitoefenen. Bagoesa en Boromesso mogen tussen Pionier en kaap Bogor in bagi doea met Pionier jagen ...

In het noorden grenst hun gebied aan dat der Kadji's (te Trimoeris) en Nomenowedja.

De Nomenowedja's zouden uit 2 groepen bestaan, nl. Nomenowedja en Pettoi.

This language is also spoken by the people in the southern hinterland of Sarmi, from the village of Muremar\_w to the village of Messentefereh on the eastern bank of the Tor River. This large language area ... includes people such as the Kaowerabeedj, Aurauweedj, Metaweedj, Murenjerwa, Airmati, Segar, and many others. There are some minor differences in dialect, but these are so slight that the people themselves are not aware of them, ...

Burmeso is spoken by the people living between the Bauzi and Kauwera peoples along the west bank of the middle Mamberamo River, concentrated in Burmeso village. It is not demonstrably related to any other language, ...

Burmeso is an isolate spoken along the eastern banks of the middle and lower Mamberamo river area ... It is spoken by about 300 people in the village of Burmeso, and in surrounding hunting and sago grounds as far as five days' walk away. It has also been referred to as Taurap (e.g. Voorheve 1975a), a name most probably derived from the word for language, tauraf. The name Burmeso (used in Silzer & Heikkinen 1991) is a name by which they call themselves that is both in current use by the government and other ethnic groups in the region, and acceptable to native speakers, ...

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**(TAURAP)**

Taurap is spoken south-west of the Mamberamo River, south of Pioniersbivak. In the south it borders on the Bauri language of the Geelvink Bay Phylum near Lake Holmes ...; in the north and west, on the opposite side of the Mamberamo, its neighbour is Kwerba ... It is not known how far the Tarap area extends towards the coast. Taurap is the language of the Monao, or Borumeso, tribe and until recently was known as Borumeso. The number of its speakers is not known.
