1 In his 1975 classification of the languages of Irian Jaya, Voohoeve classified the dialect at Foui (Fauwi) as one of 5 dialects in the Turu Family Level Isolate. It is a non-Austronesian language in the Trans-New Guinea Phylum and the Tor-Lake Plain Stock. Iau is the name given by the people of Foui to the language they speak. Foui is located in the Lakes Plains area of Irian Jaya on a branch of the Van Daalan [sic] River. There are approximately 300 speakers of this dialect. ...

Recent and more extensive surveys and field work done by SIL in the Western Lakes Plains area of Irian Jaya have resulted in the reclassification of the language called the Turu Family Level Isolate into the Turu language family consisting of the Dou language spoken at the villages of Korodesi, Doufou, Hobaresi, Tauda/Tora, Iratoi, and Foitau, and another language represented by three dialects, Iau spoken at Foui and Bakusi, Foi spoken at Taiyai and Barere, and Turu spoken at Turumo and Yereri (Bateman 1981, McAllister 1979).

Iau is one of three dialects of Turu, ... Iau is spoken by approximately 400 speakers living in the villages of Foui and Bakusi along the Van Daalen River and its tributaries. Upstream to the west, Turu is spoken in the villages of Turumo, Efo, and Yereri. The third dialect, Foi, is spoken in the villages of Taiyai and Barere to the north of Foui on the Rouffaer River.

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1 The Iau people of the central Lakes Plains area of Irian Jaya, Indonesia, are a group numbering approximately 400 divided into two villages with 350 at Fauai and about 50 at Bakusi. Traditionally hunters and gatherers, the Iau people have begun to plant gardens in the past 15 years. ...
