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The Jair, west of the [Upper Digul] river, probably belong to the Auyu people, who occupy all the territory west and south of Tanah Merah.

Jair. ... blood samples were collected along the Digul river ... in the Jair villages Kali-Win and Kali-Si, and in the villages Mariang and Tanah Tinggi. The two last mentioned have a mixed [Mandobo-Jair] population.

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[Bomakia, January, 1983]

Bomakia is one of the villages in the swamp areas of the Kouh subdistrict within the district of Merauke ... Its [sic] composed of 4 village groups, Boma, Somi, Tagiop and Womu people.

Another "clan" has just come in, the Wobohoi, who are a mixture of Jair & Kombai People [sic], but similar to the Boma People. These people have traditionally been a wandering tribe moving from feast to feast of sago grubs and pigs. Within these groups, 2 main language groups exist, the Jair and Auyu. Bomakia which was opened up in 1960/1961, ...
