Kamberataro. This language is divided generally into a north and south dialect with the division probably along the Faringi River. According to other **Kamberataro** speakers, the villages of Mengau on the northern border and Lihen on the eastern border probably form two more distinct dialects of this language.

- Loving & Bass 1964

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... Kamberatoro is located to the west and northwest / of Anggor, with villages on either side of the Dio River, and extending on into West Irian to an unknown extent. Conceivably the Anggor have moved into their present location from the northwest, splitting off from the Kamberatoro speakers. Myths and legends accounting for the origin of many Anggor ceremonies have reference to the Kamberatoro area. In other myths and legends, the Jawori or Juri speakers figure prominently as enemies or strangers, though they are situated on the opposite side of the deep Dio Gorge and present Anggor contact with them is nil. Yet the present Juri villages are located directly south of the Kamberatoro territory, separated only by short distances.

Dðra is spoken on the headwaters of the Faringi River in Papua New Guinea and in the environments of Amgotro mission station in Irian Jaya. The number of speakers is about 1,500.
