Moi is spoken in nearly the whole north-western half of the [West Bird's Head] family's territory, including the south-eastern side of Salawati Island. On Salawati, two dialects are spoken, Waipu in Waipu village, and Mosana in the villages Waliam and Yefbo. The dialect situation on the mainland is unknown. Moi shares between 35-40% cognates with Moraid, Tehit, Kalabra, and Kuwani.

Wurm places Moi/Mooi in the so-called Moi-Karon family of the West Papuan Phylum. This phylum was established by H.K.J. Cowan ... and was said to comprise quite a number of languages, amongst others the North-Halmahera Group, the non-Austronesian languages of the Bird's Head, the western part of the Bomberai Peninsula and the languages spoken on Alor, Pantar, Pura and Central and Eastern Timor (Stokhof 1975).

Voorhoeve 1975a and 1975b made a new division reducing the number of west-Papuan languages considerably. Below I list the languages spoken in the western part of the Vogelkop according to this new classification.

MOI. The term Moi is often used in a very broad sense in the west Bird's Head to include most languages. Abun, Seget, Kalabra, As, Moraid, Mare (a dialect of Brat) have all been referred to as Moi. It seems to be used as a cover all [sic] term for 'language' by those who live around Sorong.

This section deals with what is called Moi asli, that is, the original Moi. There are roughly 4,600 speakers spread around Sorong ... and in the interior. Moi was also used as a lingua franca in the area surveyed as well as on Salawati Island in the past. Moi has many dialects and minor differences within each dialect. The more important ones are,

Flassy and Stokhof (1979) regard Moi and Moraid as a single language. However this survey concludes that they are distinct.

Lexically they are less than [sic] 50% cognate, phonologically Moraid has prenasalized stops and nasal vowels, while Moi has vowel harmony. Grammatically they have different noun phrase word order.

The Moi people distinguish two main regional dialects in their language. The variety spoken in the northern part of the Moi language area (Batulobang, Makbon, Malaumkarta, Asbaken, Dala, Mega, Kalayili, Maladofok, and Sayosa) is referred to as Moi asli (original Moi), and the variety spoken in the southern part of the Moi language area (Mariat Pantai, Kalamono, Katimin, Segun, Gisim, Waimon, Yeflio, and - possibly - also in certain parts of the island of Salawati) is referred to as Moi Segin. ...

Moi is spoken by approximately 4000 people (Grimes 1992:578) in the kecamatan (subdistricts) Salawati, Sorong, and Makbon of the kabupaten (regency) Sorong in the West Bird's Head of Irian Jaya ... To what extent the Moi language is still spoken on the island of Salawati is not clear. ...
