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Galis (1955) lists Mor as being spoken in the Mor and Mambor Islands, and the villages of Mosan and Masipawa. Unfortunately the most detailed maps of Irian Jaya available do not show all the villages. The Mor (Moor) Islands (Kepulauan Moor) in the SE corner of Geelvink Bay, consists of two islands, Rutomorja (Roetomordja), on which village Moor is shown, and Ratewo, with a village Kamurai. Slightly to the west of them are the Mamboor (or Haarlem) Islands, a cluster of three small islands, on one of which is the village of Silhaam. On the mainland opposite, reading from north to south around Geelvink Bay, are the villages of Pami, Maniwori, Wainam(i), Masipawe, Napariwo, Musairo, Wamairo, Nabire, and Wanggar; apart from Masipawe (Galis' Masiapawa) it is uncertain how many of these speak (Mor Pami and Maniwori apparently speak Waropen). Names given by my informant for the principal dialects do not tally with any of these names:

dialect A: **Morá-riána**, spoken by the **matínemóti** or inhabitants of **matíne** village, lying geographically between dialects B and C.

dialect B: **Howú-riána**, spoken by the **howuróti** or inhabitants of the village of **howo** (also called **ayumbai**).

dialect C: **Worévo-riána**, spoken by the **worévoróti** (**7amuréróti**, **tárawóti**), inhabitants of the village of **worevo** (also called **7amure**, **kamure**, and **tarawa**).
