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Bij de Ajieprivier of Dajuusi (Zuid-Eilandenrivier) werd in november 1958 een kort contact verkregen met de middelmatig grote Sawoei-groep, die waarschijnlijk rondswerft in het gebied bij de oorsprongen van Foretsj-, Ewta-, Fajiet- en Kronkel-rivier. De mensen wonen in het binnenland in boomwoningen. ...

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De Sawoei-stam.

Hoe groot deze groep is, kan nog niet worden gezegd, omdat deze groep verspreid in het savanen-gebied van de Fajit-rivier, de Ewta-rivier en de Dajoesi-rivier (Ajip) hun nederzettingen hebben liggen. In het afgelopen jaar zijn er slechts bezocht geweest twee dorpen aan deze stam aan de Kronkel-rivier nl. de dorpen Moeide en Seremit en aan de Amoer-rivier de nederzettingen Seterepis I en II.

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III. Sawoeistam.

Lieden van de Sawoei-stam -- 651 zielen -- leven verspreid in de bijna ontoegankelijke moerassen tussen de Cook- en Ajiprivieren. Slechts met enkele dorpen werd tot nu toe contact verkregen.

Hiertoe behoren o,m. Sinipit en Kaibikir, waarvan echter in het geheel nog niet vaststaat dat zijn echte Sawoei-ers zijn. Het is zeer wel mogelijk dat zij de laatste vertegenwoordigers zijn van een vijfde stam, die tengevolge van de kannibalistische neigingen van hun burens zo goed als verdwenen is.

The Sawuj language is spoken by an estimated 1,500-2,000³ people living on the middle and upper Ajip river, the upper Fajit river and on the middle Kronkel river. There are 11 villages: Bawor, Kagami, Tambor, and Ero-Sato on the Ajip; Ujar-Kagas on the Fajit and Kamur, Kainam, Bawor, Esaip, Sanapi and Saremit on the Kronkel. Two more names were mentioned by informants in Kagas: Minaki and Mause. These are probably names of nomadic groups living near the Ajip river. The location of Ero-Sato is not known to the writer; the village is said to be one days' rowing upstream from Tambor.

The average is based on census figures dating from 1960, quoted in Amelsvoort 1964, i.e. Ujar - 165; Abtatie (=Kagas?) 174; Kainam - 146; Kamur - 164; Saremit - 137, and on the writer's own estimate of the size of the villages on the middle Ajip river.

The Sawuy language is spoken by an estimated 2,000 people living on the middle and upper Ayip River, the upper Fayit River, and on the middle Krokkel River. The language borders in the west and north on Asmat, and in the south on Kaugat, of the Kayagar Stock. There are at least two dialects, the Ayip River dialect and the Fayit-Kronkel River dialect. ...
