

## **SEMIMI**

The Mairasi Family occupies the main part of the neck of the Bird's Head between Etna Bay and Kamrau Bay. ... two closely related languages, Semimi in the south-east and Mairasi in the west. The two languages share more than 70% cognates; the total number of speakers probably does not exceed 3,000. Mairasi has in earlier publications also been called Faranjao; an earlier name for Semimi is Etna Bay.
