An exception to this is the District of Mamberamo Raya, which was created from a redivision of the two districts of Waropen and Sarmi.
- The *kabupaten* name is listed with its administrative capital (in parenthesis).
- **Districts/Regencies in bold** reside within the province of West Papua (as per UU45/1999, Inpres1/2003 and PP 24/2007).
- **Districts/Regencies in red** represent new administrative units/nomenclature.
- The two Municipalities (*Kota*, formerly *Kotamadya*) of Jayapura and Sorong, are indicated with an asterisk*.
